Luke 10:25-37 (Parable of the Good Samaritan) – Teaches us to show selfless compassion to those in need.

Matthew 16:24-25 – "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me. For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake will find it."

To not love our lives unto death means to put God's will above our comfort. It means choosing faithfulness over fear, service over selfishness, and eternal rewards over temporary gain.


